Boot Camp courses provide an opportunity to enhance curriculum by bringing industry to campus to teach specialized content or topics of interest. The boot camp format is an intensive five-week learning session where students are immersed in the latest industry practices, technologies, and methods. These group study courses are interactive and hands-on with limited work outside of class.
