How to schedule an advising appointment:

Please schedule an advising appointment using the Navigate scheduling system here:

All Advising appointments will be conducted by:

1. Zoom: We will send you a Zoom invitation prior to appointment (if technical issues, we will call you at the phone number you provide in the appointment Comments)
2. Phone: We will call you at the phone number you provide in the appointment Comments
3. Email: We will email your CSU address at the time of your scheduled appointment

Appointment comments section:

- Indicate your appointment preference: Zoom, Phone, or Email. Include your phone number in case there are technological issues
- Include any questions, why you are scheduling an appointment, what you would like to happen or outcomes from your appointment, information you'd like us to know

Please reserve your appointment time free from distraction (e.g., driving a car, working, grocery shopping, etc.)

ADVISING CODES ARE REQUIRED FOR FALL 2021 CLASS REGISTRATION:

- Please schedule an appointment for your Fall 2021 registration Advising code
- We will provide your Advising code verbally during the appointment (and/or through email)
- We will follow up with an email with your Advising code, verify your class schedule, and make suggested changes to your class schedule plan (if needed)

When can you register for Fall 2021 classes?

[REGISTRATION ACCESS TIMES](#) depends on your status (Senior, Junior, Sophomore, Freshman). Each student has an assigned date and time to register for class, find your specific date/time in RAMweb.

- April 5th – Priority Registration, Graduate, Professional, and Second Bachelor's Students
- April 6th – Seniors (90 or more completed credits)
- April 19th – Juniors (60 - 89 completed credits)
- April 23rd – Sophomores (30 - 59 completed credits)
- April 29th – Continuing Freshmen (up to 29 completed credits)
- May 10th – All New Undergraduate, Graduate, and Professional Level Students
